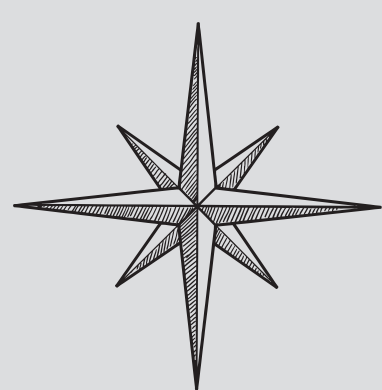
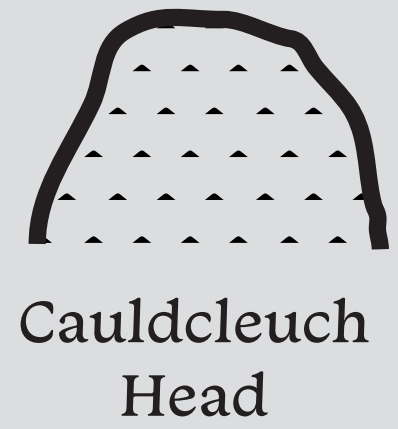

- 1** HERMITAGE CASTLE: An intimidating border fortress, with a history of treason and bloodshed, guards the valley.
- 2** NINESTANE RIG: Local legend is that the evil Lord Soulis of Hermitage Castle was boiled alive in molten lead in this stone circle in the thirteenth century.
- 3** BLOODY BUSH: A large Toll Pillar marks the Border and the site where raiders from Northumberland were killed by Liddesdale men.
